




Hence at this critical juncture the need has





















Teacher student ratio ensuring individual attention.

English Language Lab


- Speaking is often regarded as the most important skill of a language. It is an important tool to give and receive information and maintain effective social relationship by sharing personal experiences and opinions.

Responsibility of the students


- Obey the law, policies and administrative procedures laid down by the school.

The rules and regulations mentioned in the prospectus, School Diary and Report Card can be altered without any prior notice in the interest and for the smooth functioning of the school.




Admission Policy

Admission policy of South Valley International School is based on the principle of educating the students of the entire world. School provides equal learning opportunities to each and every section of society. Admission Procedure-

- 1) Admission to class I onwards will be based on performance test as per the syllabus taught in the previous class and will be subject to meeting;
- a. The child should have scored minimum 60% marks in the previous class.
 b. Should have studied in an English Medium School, preferably with CBSE
- c. No child can be considered for admission unless he/she has been registered.
- d. Registration forms are available from the Registrar at reception.
- 2) Streams offered in class XI
 - Science English, Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Biology, Information
 - practices, Physical education, Commerce English, Maths, Information practices, Economics, Accountancy, Business studies, Physical education.
- Application of student coming on transfer from other school must be supported by the Mark Sheet and Transfer Certificate mentioning the Date
- of Birth from the Head of the Institution.

 4) The Transfer Certificate / Mark Sheet must be countersigned by the competent authority of the Education Department.
